(i) Any person who is convicted of a violation of any of the provisions of § 15-502(a) of this article ("License required"), [§ 16-303] § 16-303(A) of this article ("Driving while privilege is canceled, suspended, refused, or revoked"), § 17-107 of this article ("Prohibitions"), § 21-902(a) of this article ("Driving while intoxicated"), or § 21-904 of this article ("Fleeing or eluding police") is subject to:

(1) For a first offense, a fine of not more than \$1,000 or imprisonment for not more than 1 year or both; and

(2) For any subsequent offense, a fine of not more than \$1,000 or imprisonment for not more than 2 years or both.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1986.
