

(2) 5 YEARS OF EXPERIENCE AS A FULL-TIME POLICE OFFICER WITH AN ORGANIZED POLICE AGENCY;

(3) 3 YEARS OF EXPERIENCE IN AN INVESTIGATIVE CAPACITY AS A DETECTIVE WHILE SERVING AS A POLICE OFFICER WITH AN ORGANIZED POLICE AGENCY;

(4) (I) 3 YEARS OF EXPERIENCE IN AN INVESTIGATIVE CAPACITY IN ANY UNIT OR AGENCY OF THE UNITED STATES, THE STATE, OR A COUNTY OR MUNICIPALITY OF THE STATE FOR THE PURPOSE OF LAW ENFORCEMENT; AND

(II) SUCCESSFULLY COMPLETED THE POLICE OFFICER TRAINING REQUIRED BY THE MARYLAND POLICE TRAINING COMMISSION; OR

(5) (I) 5 YEARS OF EXPERIENCE EMPLOYED AS A FULL-TIME FIRE INVESTIGATOR FOR A FIRE DEPARTMENT OR LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY OF THE STATE OR OF A COUNTY OR MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE STATE; AND

(II) SUCCESSFULLY COMPLETED THE TRAINING CERTIFIED BY THE MARYLAND POLICE TRAINING COMMISSION OR THE MARYLAND STATE FIRE RESCUE EDUCATION COMMISSION.

552. APPLICATION FOR LICENSE.

(A) IN GENERAL.

(1) AN APPLICANT FOR A LICENSE SHALL:

(I) SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO THE SUPERINTENDENT ON THE FORM THAT THE SUPERINTENDENT PROVIDES;

(II) SUBMIT THE DOCUMENTS REQUIRED UNDER THIS SECTION; AND

(III) PAY TO THE SUPERINTENDENT THE FEES REQUIRED UNDER SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION.

(2) IF THE APPLICANT IS A FIRM, THE REPRESENTATIVE MEMBER SHALL COMPLETE THE APPLICATION FORM AND OTHERWISE BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE FIRM'S COMPLIANCE WITH THIS SECTION.

(B) FEES.

(1) AN APPLICANT FOR A LICENSE SHALL PAY TO THE SUPERINTENDENT AN APPLICATION FEE OF:

(I) \$400, IF THE APPLICANT IS AN INDIVIDUAL; OR

(II) \$750, IF THE APPLICANT IS A FIRM.

(2) (I) AN APPLICANT FOR A LICENSE SHALL PAY TO THE SUPERINTENDENT A RECORDS FEE SET BY THE SUPERINTENDENT, NOT TO
