- (2) 5 YEARS OF EXPERIENCE AS A FULL-TIME POLICE OFFICER WITH AN ORGANIZED POLICE AGENCY;
- (3) 3 YEARS OF EXPERIENCE IN AN INVESTIGATIVE CAPACITY AS A DETECTIVE WHILE SERVING AS A POLICE OFFICER WITH AN ORGANIZED POLICE AGENCY:
- (4) (I) 3 YEARS OF EXPERIENCE IN AN INVESTIGATIVE CAPACITY IN ANY UNIT OR AGENCY OF THE UNITED STATES, THE STATE, OR A COUNTY OR MUNICIPALITY OF THE STATE FOR THE PURPOSE OF LAW ENFORCEMENT; AND
- (II) SUCCESSFULLY COMPLETED THE POLICE OFFICER TRAINING REQUIRED BY THE MARYLAND POLICE TRAINING COMMISSION; OR
- (5) (I) 5 YEARS OF EXPERIENCE EMPLOYED AS A FULL-TIME FIRE INVESTIGATOR FOR A FIRE DEPARTMENT OR LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY OF THE STATE OR OF A COUNTY OR MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE STATE: AND
- (II) SUCCESSFULLY COMPLETED THE TRAINING CERTIFIED BY THE MARYLAND POLICE TRAINING COMMISSION OR THE MARYLAND STATE FIRE RESCUE EDUCATION COMMISSION.
- 552. APPLICATION FOR LICENSE.
 - (A) IN GENERAL.
 - (1) AN APPLICANT FOR A LICENSE SHALL:
- (I) SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO THE SUPERINTENDENT ON THE FORM THAT THE SUPERINTENDENT PROVIDES;
- (II) SUBMIT THE DOCUMENTS REQUIRED UNDER THIS SECTION; AND
- (III) PAY TO THE SUPERINTENDENT THE FEES REQUIRED UNDER SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION.
- (2) IF THE APPLICANT IS A FIRM, THE REPRESENTATIVE MEMBER SHALL COMPLETE THE APPLICATION FORM AND OTHERWISE BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE FIRM'S COMPLIANCE WITH THIS SECTION.
 - (B) FEES.
- (1) AN APPLICANT FOR A LICENSE SHALL PAY TO THE SUPERINTENDENT AN APPLICATION FEE OF:
 - (I) \$400, IF THE APPLICANT IS AN INDIVIDUAL; OR
 - (II) \$750, IF THE APPLICANT IS A FIRM.
- (2) (I) AN APPLICANT FOR A LICENSE SHALL PAY TO THE SUPERINTENDENT A RECORDS FEE SET BY THE SUPERINTENDENT, NOT TO
