574. DENIALS, SUSPENSIONS, AND REVOCATIONS -- GROUNDS.

SUBJECT TO THE HEARING PROVISIONS OF § 576 OF THIS SUBTITLE, THE SUPERINTENDENT MAY DENY CERTIFICATION AS A PRIVATE DETECTIVE TO ANY APPLICANT, REPRIMAND ANY INDIVIDUAL CERTIFIED AS A PRIVATE DETECTIVE, OR SUSPEND OR REVOKE THE INDIVIDUAL'S CERTIFICATION:

- (1) FOR ANY GROUND SPECIFIED UNDER § 561 OF THIS SUBTITLE THAT IS APPLICABLE;
- (2) IF THE APPLICANT OR CERTIFIED INDIVIDUAL FRAUDULENTLY OR DECEPTIVELY OBTAINS OR ATTEMPTS TO OBTAIN CERTIFICATION AS A PRIVATE DETECTIVE; OR
- (3) IF THE APPLICANT OR CERTIFIED INDIVIDUAL FAILS TO MAINTAIN THE STANDARDS SET BY THE SUPERINTENDENT FOR CERTIFICATION AS A PRIVATE DETECTIVE.
- 575. SAME -- COMMENCEMENT OF PROCEEDINGS; INVESTIGATION.

## (A) COMMENCEMENT.

SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION, THE SUPERINTENDENT SHALL COMMENCE PROCEEDINGS UNDER § 574 OF THIS SUBTITLE ON THE SUPERINTENDENT'S OWN COMPLAINT OR ON THE COMPLAINT OF ANY PERSON.

## (B) FORM AND FILING OF COMPLAINT.

## (1) A COMPLAINT SHALL:

- (I) BE IN WRITING AND SIGNED BY THE COMPLAINANT; AND
- (II) STATE SPECIFICALLY THE FACTS ON WHICH THE COMPLAINT IS BASED.
- (2) IF THE COMPLAINT IS MADE BY ANY PERSON OTHER THAN THE SUPERINTENDENT, THE COMPLAINT SHALL:
- (I) BE MADE UNDER OATH BY THE PERSON WHO FILES THE COMPLAINT; AND
  - (II) BE FILED WITH THE SUPERINTENDENT.

## (C) INVESTIGATION.

(1) ON RECEIPT OF A COMPLAINT THAT ALLEGES FACTS THAT ARE GROUNDS FOR ACTION UNDER \$ 574 OF THIS SUBTITLE, THE SUPERINTENDENT SHALL APPOINT AN OFFICER OF THE MARYLAND STATE POLICE, OF THE RANK OF LIEUTENANT OR ABOVE, AS THE INVESTIGATING OFFICER FOR THE COMPLAINT.
