587. SAME -- COMMENCEMENT OF PROCEEDINGS; INVESTIGATION.

(A) COMMENCEMENT.

SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION, THE BOARD SHALL COMMENCE PROCEEDINGS UNDER § 586 OF THIS SUBTITLE ON THE SUPERINTENDENT'S OWN COMPLAINT OR ON THE COMPLAINT OF ANY PERSON.

- (B) FORM AND FILING OF COMPLAINT.
 - (1) A COMPLAINT SHALL:
- (I) BE IN WRITING AND SIGNED BY THE COMPLAINANT; AND
- (II) STATE SPECIFICALLY THE FACTS ON WHICH THE COMPLAINT IS BASED.
- (2) IF THE COMPLAINT IS MADE BY ANY PERSON OTHER THAN THE SUPERINTENDENT, THE COMPLAINT SHALL:
- (I) BE MADE UNDER OATH BY THE PERSON WHO FILES THE COMPLAINT; AND
 - (II) BE FILED WITH THE SUPERINTENDENT.
 - (C) INVESTIGATION.
- (1) ON RECEIPT OF A COMPLAINT THAT ALLEGES FACTS THAT ARE GROUNDS FOR ACTION UNDER § 586 OF THIS SUBTITLE, THE SUPERINTENDENT SHALL APPOINT AN OFFICER OF THE MARYLAND STATE POLICE, OF THE RANK OF LIEUTENANT OR ABOVE, AS THE INVESTIGATING OFFICER FOR THE COMPLAINT.
- (2) THE INVESTIGATING OFFICER MAY ASSIGN RESPONSIBILITY FOR CONDUCTING THE INVESTIGATION TO OTHER MEMBERS OF THE MARYLAND STATE POLICE.
 - (D) FINDINGS OF INVESTIGATIVE OFFICER.
- (1) ON CONCLUSION OF THE INVESTIGATION, THE INVESTIGATION OFFICER SHALL DETERMINE IF THERE IS A REASONABLE BASIS TO BELIEVE THAT THERE ARE GROUNDS FOR DISCIPLINARY ACTION UNDER § 586 OF THIS SUBTITLE AGAINST THE CERTIFICATION APPLICANT OR CERTIFIED SECURITY GUARD.
- (2) IF THE INVESTIGATING OFFICER FINDS A REASONABLE BASIS UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION, THE SUPERINTENDENT SHALL ACT ON THE COMPLAINT AS PROVIDED UNDER § 588 OF THIS SUBTITLE.
