- (1) IS A RESIDENT OF THE STATE; AND
- (2) (I) HOLDS, AS AN INDIVIDUAL, THE PRIVATE DETECTIVE AGENCY'S LICENSE; OR
- (II) IS THE REPRESENTATIVE MEMBER OF THE PRIVATE DETECTIVE AGENCY APPOINTED UNDER § 550(B) OF THIS SUBTITLE.
  - (B) NOTICE OF APPOINTMENTS AND VACANCIES.
- IF A PRIVATE DETECTIVE AGENCY IS A FIRM, THE AGENCY SHALL NOTIFY THE SUPERINTENDENT REGARDING:
- (1) THE IDENTITY OF THE INDIVIDUAL SERVING AS THE REPRESENTATIVE MEMBER OF THE AGENCY; AND
  - (2) ANY VACANCY IN THAT POSITION.
  - (C) APPOINTMENT OF REPLACEMENT.
- (1) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, A PRIVATE DETECTIVE AGENCY SHALL APPOINT A REPRESENTATIVE MEMBER WITHIN 90 DAYS AFTER A VACANCY OCCURS IN THE POSITION.
- (2) IF THE VACANCY IS CAUSED BY THE DEATH OR AN INCAPACITATING INJURY OF THE REPRESENTATIVE MEMBER, THE AGENCY SHALL APPOINT A REPLACEMENT WITHIN 180 DAYS AFTER THE VACANCY OCCURS.
  - (D) SUSPENSION OF LICENSE.
- IF A LICENSEE FAILS TO APPOINT A REPRESENTATIVE MEMBER AS REQUIRED UNDER SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION, THE LICENSE OF THE PRIVATE DETECTIVE AGENCY SHALL:
  - (1) BE SUSPENDED AUTOMATICALLY; AND
- (2) REMAIN SUSPENDED UNTIL THE LICENSEE COMPLIES WITH THE REOUIREMENTS.
  - (E) REGULATIONS.

THE SUPERINTENDENT MAY ADOPT REGULATIONS TO CARRY OUT THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION.

- 593. SURETY BONDS.
  - (A) IN GENERAL.
- (1) SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION, AN APPLICANT FOR A LICENSE SHALL EXECUTE A BOND TO THE STATE CONDITIONED ON THE FAITHFUL AND HONEST CONDUCT OF THE APPLICANT
