CHAPTER 101

(House Bill 776)

AN ACT concerning

Smokeless Tobacco - Sale to Minors

FOR the purpose of providing that a dealer, vendor, or other person may not sell, barter, or give any smokeless tobacco product to an individual under a certain age; providing a certain exception; providing that certain persons may not purchase any smokeless tobacco for an individual under a certain age; and subjecting violators of this Act to a certain penalty.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 27 - Crimes and Punishments

404.

It shall not be lawful for any dealer, vendor or other person or persons or body corporate engaged in the manufacture of cigars, cigarettes [or], tobacco, OR SMOKELESS TOBACCO, or in any occupation in which the buying or selling of said goods, wares
