ANY A CEASE AND DESIST ORDER SHALL GRANT THE RESPONDENT AN OPPORTUNITY TO REQUEST A HEARING UNDER § 13-403, AND THE HEARING SHALL BE HELD NO LATER THAN 7 DAYS AFTER THE REQUEST. IF NO REQUEST IS MADE, ANY ORDER ENTERED UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL BE FINAL 30 DAYS AFTER ENTRY.
- (B) [Failure to comply with § 14-12B-02] EACH SALE OF A HEALTH CLUB SERVICES AGREEMENT THAT VIOLATES ANY PROVISION of this subtitle, OR A VIOLATION OF § 14-12B-07 OF THIS SUBTITLE, is an unfair or deceptive trade practice Within-The-MEANING-OF COMMERCIAL LAW ARTICLE.
