(VIII) THE MARYLAND HIGHER EDUCATION SUPPLEMENTAL LOAN AUTHORITY, TO THE EXTENT THAT NO MONEYS OF THE STATE ARE TO BE EXPENDED ON A CONTRACT;

(IX) THE MARYLAND INDUSTRIAL TRAINING PROGRAM OF THE DEPARTMENT OF ECONOMIC AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT FOR TRAINING PROGRAMS FOR NEW OR EXPANDING BUSINESSES OR INDUSTRIES;

(X) THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE MARYLAND STATE RETIREMENT AND PENSION SYSTEMS AND THE STATE INVESTMENT AGENCY FOR SERVICES RELATED TO THE EXTERNAL MANAGEMENT OF THE INVESTMENT OF ASSETS OF THE RETIREMENT SYSTEMS; AND

(XI) THE MARYLAND FOOD CENTER AUTHORITY, <u>TO THE EXTENT THE AUTHORITY 1S EXEMPT UNDER TITLE 40 OF ARTICLE 41 OF THE CODE</u> EXCEPT-FOR-THE--MINORITY--BUSINESS--PARTICIPATION REQUIREMENTS-SET-FORTH-IN-\$-11-148-OF-THIS-SUBTITLE-;

FOR ARTISTS' SERVICES FOR ALL EDUCATION AND CULTURAL TELEVISION PRODUCTIONS; AND

FOR CULTURAL, ENTERTAINMENT, AND INTERCOLLEGIATE ATHLETIC CONTRACTS.
