

(C) THE TIME FOR HEARING AND DETERMINATION MAY BE EXTENDED BY THE BOARD FOR GOOD CAUSE SHOWN.

12-105. PETITION FOR REINSTATEMENT.

(A) (1) ANY PERSON DISQUALIFIED UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SUBTITLE MAY, AFTER A PERIOD OF 5 YEARS FROM THE DATE OF THE DISQUALIFICATION, PETITION THE BOARD FOR REMOVAL OF THE DISQUALIFICATION.

(2) WITHIN 90 DAYS AFTER RECEIPT OF THE PETITION, THE BOARD OR A HEARING EXAMINER APPOINTED BY THE BOARD SHALL CONDUCT A HEARING AND DETERMINE WHETHER THE PERSON'S DISQUALIFICATION SHOULD BE REMOVED.

(B) (1) IN MAKING ITS DETERMINATION, THE BOARD SHALL CONSIDER THE FACTORS SET FORTH IN § 12-104 OF THIS SUBTITLE AND CONCLUDE WHETHER OR NOT THE INTEGRITY OF THE CONTRACTING PROCESS AND THE BEST INTERESTS OF THE STATE WOULD BE SERVED BY CONTINUING THE PERSON'S DISQUALIFICATION.

(2) UPON MAKING ITS DETERMINATION, THE BOARD SHALL NOTIFY THE PETITIONER IN WRITING EITHER THAT:

(I) THE DISQUALIFICATION HAS BEEN REMOVED; OR

(II) THE DISQUALIFICATION HAS BEEN CONTINUED.

(B) IF THE CONVICTION FORMING THE BASIS FOR DISQUALIFICATION OF ANY PERSON UNDER THIS SUBTITLE IS REVERSED OR OTHERWISE RENDERED VOID, THAT PERSON'S DISQUALIFICATION SHALL AUTOMATICALLY TERMINATE.

(C) THE TIME FOR A HEARING AND DETERMINATION BY THE BOARD UNDER THIS SECTION MAY BE EXTENDED BY THE BOARD UPON A SHOWING OF GOOD CAUSE.

12-106. INVESTIGATION BY ATTORNEY GENERAL.

(A) THE ATTORNEY GENERAL SHALL CONDUCT AN INVESTIGATION OF THE MATTERS TO BE DETERMINED BY THE BOARD IN ANY HEARING UNDER THIS SUBTITLE AND SHALL PRESENT TO THE BOARD, AS A PARTY TO THE PROCEEDINGS, SUCH EVIDENCE AS HE DEEMS APPROPRIATE.

(B) A HEARING UNDER THIS SUBTITLE SHALL BE CONDUCTED IN ACCORDANCE WITH TITLE 10, SUBTITLE 2, OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE.

12-107. AFFIDAVIT OF "NO CONVICTION" FOR BRIBERY, ATTEMPTED BRIBERY, OR CONSPIRACY TO BRIBE.

(A) EVERY PERSON, UPON SUBMITTING A BID OR OTHERWISE APPLYING FOR A CONTRACT WITH THE STATE OR ANY OF ITS SUBDIVISIONS, SHALL SUBMIT AN AFFIDAVIT STATING TO ITS BEST KNOWLEDGE WHETHER IT OR ANY OF ITS OFFICERS, DIRECTORS, OR
