

under this subtitle for the preceding calendar year, including each recommendation which he has received from the Council during the preceding calendar year and including full information as to the operation of the subtitle and other information and data he deems desirable in connection with prevailing hourly wage rates.

(c) The Commissioner may call upon other agencies of the State and local governments for statistical data, reports, and other information which will assist the Council in the performance of its duties.

(d) (1) Appointed members of the Council shall serve terms of 3 years except as hereinafter provided and shall be eligible for reappointment. Of the members first appointed, the two selected from the general public shall serve terms of 2 years each; one management member and one labor member shall serve a term of 1 year each; and the other two shall serve a term of 3 years each.

(2) The Governor shall appoint a member of the Advisory Council on Prevailing Wage Rates as chairman who shall serve in that capacity for 1 year from date of appointment and qualification and may not be eligible for reappointment as chairman for the following year.

(3) Any vacancies occurring in any term of a member of the Council shall be filled by the Governor's appointment with the advice of the Secretary of Licensing and Regulation for the remainder of the term. The members shall be compensated on a per diem basis as set forth in the annual State budget from time to time, and they shall be allowed reasonable expenses for travel in accordance with the Standard Travel Regulations.
