

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall apply only to contracts issued or renewed after the effective date of this Act.

SECTION -2- 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1986. It shall remain effective for a period of 3 years and, at the end of June 30, 1989, and with no further action required by the General Assembly, Sections 354D(a), 470E(a), and 477E(a) as enacted by this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect. On July 1, 1989, Sections 354D(a), 470E(a), and 477E(a) as enacted by this Act shall be revived and the Michie Publishing Company shall include Sections 354D(a), 470E(a), and 477E(a) in the Annotated Code of Maryland as these sections existed before July 1, 1986.

CHAPTER 844

(Senate Bill 74)

AN ACT concerning

Drug Addiction - Commitment of Inmates

FOR the purpose of repealing certain provisions of law that provide for petitions by inmates for commitment to the Drug Abuse Administration as addicts; repealing certain provisions of law that relate to procedures after petition by inmates; deleting certain provisions of law that relate to the commitment, supervision, discharge on rehabilitation, and termination of the commitment of inmates; providing for the application of this Act with respect to proceedings pending on a certain date; and providing for the application of this Act with respect to inmates committed before a certain date.
