SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Health - General

[Part V. Commitment of Inmate in Correctional Institution.] [9-637.

An individual may not be committed under Part V of this subtitle if the individual:

- (1) Is serving a sentence for a crime other than theft, if the crime is punishable by more than 10 years imprisonment or by death; or
 - (2) Is charged with another crime.]

[9-638.

- (a) If an inmate in a correctional institution in this State believes that the inmate is a drug addict, the inmate may file a petition to be committed to the Administration as provided in Part V of this subtitle.
- (b) A petition under this section may be filed with the circuit court for the county where the correctional institution is located.
 - (c) A petition under this section shall:
 - (1) Be signed and verified by the petitioner;
 - (2) State the petitioner's:
 - (i) Name;
 - (ii) Address;
 - (iii) Telephone number, if any;
 - (iv) Birth date;
 - (v) Birth place;
 - (vi) Age;
 - (vii) Sex;
 - (viii) Marital status;
