RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Governor is requested to establish a task force to develop and implement a comprehensive plan designed to combat teenage child, teenage, and young adult suicide and associated mental health concerns; and be it further

RESOLVED, That the task force be strongly encouraged to consider, as components of its recommended plan:

- (1) The implementation of appropriate training programs for teachers <u>all school personnel and volunteers</u> and appropriate institutional and residential care facilities staff;
- (2) The development of teenage child, teenage, and young adult suicide and mental health curriculum training programs for junior and senior high schools and appropriate institutions and residential care facilities;
- (3) The development of informational products and presentations for community organizations and groups and for parents, either individually or in groups;
- (4) The development of appropriate informational products or presentations for teenage-students children, teenage students, and young adults;
- (5) The identification of mental health resources and treatment programs and centers in local communities; and be it further

RESOLVED, That the task force be composed of 18 members, appointed as follows:

- (1) 2 principals, 1 from a senior high school and 1 from a junior high school in this State;
- (2) 1 social worker, specializing in mental health concerns;
 - (3) I registered nurse specializing in school health;
 - (4) l psychologist; `
 - (5) 1 psychiatrist;
- (6) 1 police officer, specializing in juvenile matters;
- (7) 2 school guidance counselors, 1 from a senior high school and 1 from a junior high school in this State;
- (8) l representative from the State Department of Education;
- (9) 1 representative from the State Department of Health and Mental Hygiene; and
