Highway Deicing Salts and Chemicals - Effects on Chesapeake Bay

FOR the purpose of establishing a task force to study the effects on the Chesapeake Bay of salts and other chemicals used to deice highways.

WHEREAS, The Chesapeake Bay is a natural resource of inestimable value to the State and the nation; and

WHEREAS, This State has acknowledged the great importance of the Chesapeake Bay by taking measures to restore and protect the Bay, its tributaries, and adjacent lands; and

WHEREAS, Salts and other chemicals used to deice highways may have a detrimental effect on soils, vegetation, and surface water and groundwater supplies, thereby negating the positive efforts made to clean up the Bay and to protect its delicate ecosystem; and
