

(1) 2 members of the House of Delegates, appointed by the Speaker of the House, and 2 members of the Senate of Maryland, appointed by the President of the Senate; and

(2) 2 representatives of the Department of Transportation, including a representative of the State Highway Administration, appointed by the Secretary of Transportation; and

(3) A representative from the Department of Natural Resources appointed by the Secretary of Natural Resources, and a representative of the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene appointed by the Secretary of Health and Mental Hygiene; and be it further

RESOLVED, That the task force designate its own Chairman; and be it further

RESOLVED, That the task force report its findings and recommendations to the General Assembly by December 31, 1986; and be it further

RESOLVED, That staff for the task force be provided by the Department of Legislative Reference; and be it further
