(5) 2 members appointed by the Governor, representing the public; and

(6) 1 member ~~appointed by the Governor~~ who formerly suffered from an eating disorder and is a member of the Maryland Association of Anorexia and Bulimia, appointed by the Governor; and be it further

RESOLVED, That the Governor designate the Chairman of the task force on eating disorders; and be it further;

RESOLVED, That the task force on eating disorders report its findings and recommendations to the Governor by July 1, 1987; and be it further;

RESOLVED, That the Governor shall appropriate staff resources to staff the task force, and be it further

A House Joint Resolution concerning

Commission on Education in Agriculture

FOR the purpose of requesting the Governor to establish a Commission on Education in Agriculture to study existing programs and policies concerning education in agriculture; grades kindergarten through 12, vocational agriculture on the secondary level, postsecondary technical training, and teacher training in agriculture at the university level; and
