RESOLVED, That the Committee be composed of:

(1) 4 2 members of the House of Delegates, appointed by the Speaker of the House, and 4 2 members of the Senate of Maryland, appointed by the President of the Senate; and

(2) The Secretary of Personnel; and

(3) 3 representatives from the major associations representing State employees, and 3 members of the public who may be State employees appointed by the Speaker and President on the Governor's recommendation; and be it further

RESOLVED, That the Chairman of the Committee be appointed by the President and Speaker the Secretary of the Department of Personnel or a designee of the Secretary; and be it further

RESOLVED, That the Committee Secretary of Personnel consult with the Secretaries of the major departments, representatives of private industry with experience in this field, representatives of the Maryland Commission for Women, and other appropriate individuals; and be it further

RESOLVED, That the Committee report its findings and recommendations to the Legislative Policy Committee by December 1, 1986; and be it further

RESOLVED, That support for the Committee be provided by--the Department--of--Fiscal--Services--and--the--Department--of--Legislative Reference;--that--the--Department--of--Personnel--should--provide, directly or through consultants, any necessary assistance; and be it further
