- (4) 1 member from the Maryland Department of Natural Resources, appointed by the Governor;
- (5) 1 member from Maryland--Environmental--Service State Water Quality Advisory Committee, appointed by the Governon;
- (6) 1 member from the Maryland Department of State Planning, appointed by the Governor;
- (7) I member from private industry involved in the provision of sewage treatment, appointed by the Governor; and
- (8) 1 member from the environmental community <u>appointed by</u> the Governor; and
- (9) 1 member of--the--general--public with expertise in investment banking, appointed by the Governor; and be it further

RESOLVED, That the Legislative Policy Committee designate the chairman of the committee; and be it further

RESOLVED, That the committee shall report its findings and recommendations to the General Assembly and the Governor by December 1, 1986; and be it further

RESOLVED, That staff for the Committee be provided by the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene and the Department of State Planning; and be it further
