In accordance with Article II, Section 17 of the Maryland Constitution, I have today vetoed Senate Bill 579.

This bill authorizes the governing body of Carroll County to order the owner of a radio or television transmitting tower equipped with a certain system of aviation obstruction lights to install an alternate system of lighting, consistent with applicable State and federal aviation regulations.

House Bill 1533, which was passed by the General Assembly and signed by me on May 27, 1986, accomplishes the same purpose. Therefore, it is not necessary for me to sign Senate Bill 579.
