SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 48A - Insurance Code

477K.

(d) The Commissioner shall establish notification requirements for the insurer to the person whose coverage is being terminated of his right of conversion, and requirements regarding the timely election of the conversion privilege. The requirements for notification shall include, but need not be limited to, a provision in any certificates furnished persons covered under group and blanket health insurance policies setting forth the conditions applicable to election of the conversion privilege. EXCEPT AS PROVIDED ELSEWHERE IN THIS ARTICLE;
