SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Family Law

5-203.

(c) (1) If the parents live apart, a court may award SOLE custody of a minor child to either parent OR JOINT CUSTODY TO BOTH PARENTS.

(2) Neither parent is presumed to have any right to custody that is superior to the right of the other parent.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1986.

Dear Mr. President:

In accordance with Article II, Section 17 of the Maryland Constitution, I have today vetoed Senate Bill 700.

This bill requires that a subpoena concerning a credit card account and sent to the card-issuing entity must certify that the account holder was served the subpoena by the party requesting the subpoena or that service was waived by the court for good cause.

House Bill 75, which was passed by the General Assembly and signed by me on May 13, 1986, accomplishes the same purpose. Therefore, it is not necessary for me to sign Senate Bill 700.
