 Section 13-614  
 Annotated Code of Maryland

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Transportation

13-614.

(a) (1) The owner of any vehicle described in paragraph (2) of this subsection may apply to the Administration for the assignment to that vehicle of a special, veterans' organization registration number, if the applicant is a member of:

(i) The Department of Maryland, Veterans of Foreign Wars of the United States;

(ii) The Department of Maryland, Disabled American Veterans of the United States; or

(iii) The Department of Maryland, American Legion.

(2) This section applies only as to:

(i) A Class A (passenger) vehicle; [or]

(ii) A Class E (truck) vehicle with a 3/4 ton or less manufacturer's rated capacity; OR

(III) A CLASS M (MULTIPURPOSE) VEHICLE.

(b) Special registration may be issued under this section only if:

(1) The applicant submits proof satisfactory to the Administration that the applicant is a member of one of the organizations specified in subsection (a) of this section; and

(2) The department commander or department adjutant of that organization certifies to the Administration that the request:

(i) Has been cleared through his office; and

(ii) As to Veterans of Foreign Wars and Disabled American Veterans, is not in excess of the number of registration plates that the Administration determines can be manufactured with the combinations permitted under this title.
