

FOR the purpose of requiring transient or temporary vendors to be licensed in Frederick County; establishing a procedure for the application for this license; excepting certain vendors from the provisions of this Act; establishing a fee schedule for and time limitation on the duration of the license; establishing a criminal provision and penalty for the failure to obtain a license as required under this section; and generally relating to the licensure and regulation of transient or temporary vendors in Frederick County.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 56 - Licenses

31B.

(A) THIS SECTION APPLIES ONLY TO FREDERICK COUNTY.

(B) IN THIS SECTION, THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED.

(1) "TRANSIENT OR TEMPORARY VENDORS" MEANS ALL PERSONS, PARTNERSHIPS, CORPORATIONS, OR OTHER LEGAL ENTITIES, AND THEIR PRINCIPALS AND AGENTS, WHO:

(I) ENGAGE IN A BUSINESS FOR THE PURPOSE OF SELLING OR SOLICITING ORDERS FOR THE SALE OF GOODS, WARES, OR MERCHANDISE;

(II) ARE LOCATED IN ONE LOCATION OR TRAVEL FROM PLACE TO PLACE;

(III) HAVE THE INTENT TO CONTINUE THIS BUSINESS IN FREDERICK COUNTY FOR A PERIOD OF A YEAR OR LESS; AND

(IV) FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONDUCTING THIS BUSINESS, RENT, USE, OR OCCUPY THE FOLLOWING:

1. BUILDINGS, INCLUDING:

A. ROOMS OR HALLS IN MOTELS, HOTELS, OR OTHER LODGING HOUSES; OR

B. PUBLIC AUDITORIUMS, FACILITIES, OR CIVIC CENTERS;

2. ANY LOTS OR PARCELS OF LAND INCLUDING:
