In accordance with Article II, Section 17 of the Maryland Constitution, I have today vetoed House Bill 1334.

This bill authorizes the Anne Arundel County Council to enact ordinances to fix, impose, and collect development impact fees for financing the capital costs of additional or expanded public works, improvements, and facilities required to accommodate new construction or development.

Senate Bill 607, which was passed by the General Assembly and signed by me on May 13, 1986, accomplishes the same purpose. Therefore, it is not necessary for me to sign House Bill 1334.
