SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Financial Institutions

[4-101.

In this title, "savings bank" means an institution that:

- (1) Is incorporated under the laws of this State as a savings bank; and
- (2) Engages only in the business of savings banking.] 4-101.
- IN THIS TITLE, THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED.
 - (B) (1) "SAVINGS BANK" MEANS AN INSTITUTION THAT:
- STATE AS A SAVINGS BANK; AND IS INCORPORATED UNDER THE LAWS OF THIS
- (II) ENGAGES ONLY IN THE BUSINESS OF SAVINGS BANKING.
- (2) THE TERM "SAVINGS BANK" INCLUDES A SUBSIDIARY BANK FOR THE PURPOSE OF APPLYING THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SAVINGS ARTICLE.
 - (C) "SUBSIDIARY SAVINGS BANK" MEANS AN INSTITUTION THAT:
- IS INCORPORATED UNDER THE LAWS OF THIS STATE AS A SUBSIDIARY SAVINGS BANK, ALL OF THE STOCK OF WHICH IS OWNED BY A MUTUAL HOLDING COMPANY;
- (2) ENGAGES ONLY IN THE BUSINESS OF SAVINGS BANKING; -AND-
