- WHEREAS, Each of the inmates listed on the attachment to this Executive Order was convicted in this State by a court of competent jurisdiction and is presently nearing the expiration date of the sentence imposed; and
- WHEREAS, Each of the inmates is in the custody of the Commissioner of Correction for the State of Maryland;
- WHEREAS, The Commissioner of Correction and Maryland Parole Commission have reviewed, approved, and recommended the commutations of sentences of inmates within the custody of the Division of Correction; and
- WHEREAS, Assurances have been received from the Commissioner of Correction; and that
 - (1) Each inmate has a mandatory release date between December 24, 1985, and May 31, 1986;
 - (2) There are no detainers or pending charges against any of these inmates;
