DECEMBER, 1985, COMMUTATIONS OF INMATES WITHIN THE

DIVISION OF CORRECTION

WHEREAS, Each of the inmates listed on the attachment to this Executive Order was convicted in this State by a court of competent jurisdiction and is presently nearing the expiration date of the sentence imposed; and

WHEREAS, Each of the inmates is in the custody of the Commissioner of Correction for the State of Maryland;

WHEREAS, The Commissioner of Correction and Maryland Parole Commission have reviewed, approved, and recommended the commutations of sentences of inmates within the custody of the Division of Correction; and

WHEREAS, Assurances have been received from the Commissioner of Correction; and that

- (1) Each inmate has a mandatory release date between December 24, 1985, and May 31, 1986;
- (2) There are no detainers or pending charges against any of these inmates;
- (3) None of these inmates has served a disciplinary segregation term since October 18, 1985;
- (4) None of these inmates is serving a commitment for escape, attempted escape, or assault on correctional personnel, since April, 1983;
- (5) None of these inmates has served or is serving a sentence for a probation violation and/or parole revocation.
