CHARTER AMENDMENT NO. 107-85-1

RESOLUTION of the Commissioners of Cambridge, Maryland, adopted pursuant to the authority of Art. 11 E of the Constitution of Maryland and Sec. 13 of Art. 23A of the Annotated Code of Maryland, 1957 Ed., as amended, entitled "Corporations - Municipal" to amend the Charter of the Commissioners of Cambridge by repealing and reenacting, with amendments, Section 3-5, entitled "Commissioners; number, election, tenure, qualifications." of Chapter 3 of the Public Local Laws of Dorchester County, 1974 Ed., to provide that the election of commissioners shall be from each individual ward.
