A RESOLUTION OF MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF FUNKSTOWN, a municipal corporation under Article 23A of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1981 Replacement Volume, 1984 Cumulative Supplement), to amend Section 14-13 of the Code of the Public Local Laws of Washington County (1970 Edition), being Article 22 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, Section 14-13 being a part of the Charter of Mayor and Council of Funkstown, to provide an exception to the
