

(4) THE SECRETARY OF BUDGET AND FISCAL PLANNING;

(5) THE STATE SUPERINTENDENT OF SCHOOLS;

(6) THE DIRECTOR OF THE OFFICE ON CHILDREN AND YOUTH;

(7) 1 MEMBER OF THE SENATE OF MARYLAND NOMINATED BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE;

(8) 1 MEMBER OF THE HOUSE OF DELEGATES OF MARYLAND NOMINATED BY THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE;

(9) 3 PERSONS WITH EXTENSIVE PROGRAMMATIC OR ACADEMIC EXPERIENCE WITH PREGNANT OR PARENTING ADOLESCENTS AND THEIR FAMILIES;

(10) 5 PERSONS INCLUDING REPRESENTATIVES OF COMMUNITY, PARENT, OR RELIGIOUS GROUPS OR ORGANIZATIONS WHO HAVE INTEREST OR EXPERTISE IN MATTERS PERTAINING TO ADOLESCENT PREGNANCY AND PARENTING; AND

(11) 2 REPRESENTATIVES OF LOCAL GOVERNMENT IN AREAS WITH A SIGNIFICANT INCIDENCE OF ADOLESCENT PREGNANCY.

(B) (1) THE TERM OF A MEMBER APPOINTED PURSUANT TO PARAGRAPHS (A)(9), (10), AND (11) OF THIS SUBSECTION SHALL BE 3 YEARS.

(2) THE TERMS OF MEMBERS APPOINTED PURSUANT TO PARAGRAPHS (A)(9), (10), AND (11) OF THIS SUBSECTION SHALL BE STAGGERED AS REQUIRED BY THE TERMS PROVIDED FOR PUBLIC MEMBERS ON JULY 1, 1986.

(3) AT THE END OF A TERM, A MEMBER SHALL CONTINUE TO SERVE UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS APPOINTED AND QUALIFIES.

(4) A MEMBER WHO IS APPOINTED PURSUANT TO PARAGRAPHS (A)(9), (10) AND (11) OF THIS SUBSECTION AFTER A TERM HAS BEGUN SHALL SERVE ONLY FOR THE REST OF THE TERM OR UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS APPOINTED.

(C) THE GOVERNOR SHALL APPOINT A SUCCESSOR IN THE EVENT OF A VACANCY ON THE COUNCIL.

(D) A MEMBER OF THE COUNCIL:

(1) MAY NOT RECEIVE COMPENSATION; BUT

(2) IS ENTITLED TO REIMBURSEMENT FOR REASONABLE EXPENSES INCURRED IN THE PERFORMANCE OF COUNCIL DUTIES, IN ACCORDANCE WITH STANDARD STATE TRAVEL REGULATIONS AND AS PROVIDED IN THE STATE BUDGET.

(E) FROM AMONG THE MEMBERS OF THE COUNCIL, THE GOVERNOR SHALL DESIGNATE A CHAIRMAN FOR A 2-YEAR TERM.
