- (a) In this section, "youth services bureau" means a community based entity that is operated:
- (1) To provide community oriented delinquency prevention, YOUTH SUICIDE PREVENTION, and youth development;
- (2) To ameliorate conditions that breed delinquency, YOUTH SUICIDE, and family disruption; and
 - (3) To function as an advocate of youth needs.
- (b) (1) The Administration shall adopt rules and regulations that set eligibility guidelines for State funding of youth services bureaus under this section.
- (2) The rules and regulations shall require that each State aided youth services bureau provide, free of charge, at convenient hours:
 - (i) Individual, family, and group counseling;
 - (ii) Referral and information services;
- (iii) Crisis intervention, INCLUDING INTERVENTION RELATING TO YOUTH SUICIDE PREVENTION;
 - (iv) Informal counseling; and
- (v) In accordance with particular community needs:
 - 1. Tutoring;
 - 2. Alternative leisure activities;

- Employment assistance;
- 4. Community education, INCLUDING TRAINING AND INFORMATION RELATING TO YOUTH SUICIDE PREVENTION; and
 - Other specialized services.
 - (c) The Administration shall:
- (1) As to each youth services bureau receiving State funding:
 - (i) Monitor its operations;
 - (ii) Evaluate annually its effectiveness; and
