

(4) A description of the procedures used by the subdivision to select the projects to be included in the accounting of intended use required under item (2) of this subsection, including the methods of solicitation and degree of participation in those procedures by the public; AND

(5) A CERTIFICATION THAT ANY SUCH FUNDS WILL BE EXPENDED ONLY TO ASSIST THE FUNDING OF SERVICES AND FACILITIES LOCATED WITHIN 2 MILES OF PIMLICO RACETRACK OR 3 MILES OF LAUREL RACETRACK.

(e) (1) The Comptroller shall not pay any funds to any subdivision [to assist in funding services or facilities located within 2 miles of Pimlico racetrack or 3 miles of Laurel racetrack] UNDER SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION unless the subdivision submits by the specified time a report containing the information required by subsection (d) of this section.

(2) Any such funds which would otherwise be available for payments in any fiscal year to a subdivision, but which are not so paid because of the provisions of this subsection, shall be held by the Comptroller in a special account and added to the moneys available for payment in the next fiscal year to that subdivision.

(f) The restriction on the use of certain funds by subdivisions within 2 miles of Pimlico racetrack or 3 miles of Laurel racetrack is applicable to funds paid after July 1, 1985, and does not limit the use of funds paid to certain subdivisions prior to that date.

(g) After all deductions have been made from the special fund, any remaining revenues shall be paid to the General Fund of the State.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1986.
