- (a) Except in the District Court and except as provided in this section, an attorney-at-law is entitled to demand and receive the following fees:
- (1) For bringing, prosecuting, or defending any action at law in a court of original jurisdiction -- \$5;
- (2) For prosecuting or defending any action, including the collection of money due on mortgage, in a court of equity -- \$10;
- (3) For prosecuting or defending a case in the Court
 of Appeals -- \$10;
- (4) For prosecuting or defending a criminal case if the punishment for the offense charged is death or confinement in the penitentiary -- \$10;
 - (5) In all other criminal cases -- \$5.
- (T) (1) IN GARRETT COUNTY, THE CLERK OF THE CIRCUIT COURT SHALL DEPOSIT MONTHLY ALL APPEARANCE FEES COLLECTED UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION INTO A SPECIAL ACCOUNT TO BE KNOWN AS THE GARRETT COUNTY LAW LIBRARY FUND.
- (2) THE FUND SHALL BE USED ONLY FOR THE ACQUISITION OF BOOKS AND OTHER PUBLICATIONS, LIBRARY EQUIPMENT, AND FOR OTHER NECESSARY EXPENSES, AS DETERMINED BY THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATIVE JUDGE.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1986.
