Any surety or the personal representative of any surety, upon the official bond of any State, county, municipal or other public officer who is, by the Constitution of the State of Maryland, or by any law, ordinance, rule or regulation, required to give such bond, may be discharged from further liability as such surety upon application by petition to the court, judge, officer, board or other person or persons or body having authority to approve such bond, who shall thereupon immediately, by order reciting such application, require such public officer to furnish a new bond in the same manner as if none had ever been given by him within thirty days after personal service of such order. Such personal service may be made either within or without the State of Maryland by the said court, judge, officer, board or other person or persons or body, or by any person authorized by them or at their request, by the surety or any agent or representative of the surety.
