- (a) As used in this article the following terms shall have the meanings indicated unless a contrary meaning is clearly intended from the context in which the term appears:
 - (6A) "ELDERLY" MEANS 65 YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER.

(a) (3) Every polling place, to the extent feasible, shall be structurally barrier free in order to permit reasonable access, for the purpose of voting, to [physically] ELDERLY AND handicapped voters. [For the purposes of this section, "physically handicapped voter" means any voter who has temporarily or permanently lost the use of a leg or both legs or a foot or both feet or any combination; who is so severely disabled as to be unable to move without the aid of braces, canes, crutches or a wheelchair; whose mobility is significantly impaired by reason of heart or lung disease; who suffers from hemophilia; or who is blind or whose vision is substantially impaired.]
