

(2) THE AMOUNT OF HAZARDOUS WASTE HANDLED BY THE FACILITY;

(3) THE NATURE OF THE WASTE HANDLED BY THE FACILITY;
AND

(4) THE RECORD OF COMPLIANCE BY THE FACILITY WITH THIS SUBTITLE AND THE REGULATIONS ADOPTED UNDER THIS SUBTITLE.

(b) (1) The Department shall keep records of the date and findings of each inspection under this section and these records are public records.

(2) The Department periodically shall publish and make available to the public a list of the dates each controlled hazardous substance facility is inspected under this section.

(c) The Secretary may delegate to the health officer of any county where a controlled hazardous substance facility is located the authority to make inspections under this section.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1986.

CHAPTER 207

(House Bill 510)

AN ACT concerning

Baltimore County - Alcoholic Beverages - Board of License Commissioners

FOR the purpose of altering the minimum amount that a chairman or an associate member of the Baltimore County board of license commissioners may be paid as an annual salary; and providing that this Act does not apply to incumbent board members.
