SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Family Law

[3-105.

- (a) A person may not:
- (1) assert or settle a claim abolished or prohibited by this title;
- (2) file or threaten to file an action prohibited by this title; $\ensuremath{\mathsf{OR}}$
- (3) -f-attempt to induce another individual to assert, settle, file, or threaten to file an action prohibited by this title; or
- (4)- $\frac{1}{2}$ receive or accept any money or thing of value knowing that it is in payment of a claim abolished or prohibited by this title.
- (b) A person who violates any provision of this section is guilty of a misdemeanor and on conviction is subject to a fine not exceeding \$5,000 or imprisonment not exceeding 5 years or both.]
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1986.

AN ACT concerning

Garrett County - Emergency Snow Routes

FOR the purpose of authorizing the County Commissioners for Garrett County to designate and control the use of a county
