- (a) (1) The fee for a license is \$10.
 - (2) The clerk shall:
 - (i) retain \$5 of the fee; and
- $% \left(11\right) =100$ (ii) pay \$5 of the fee into the general fund of the county.
- (b) (1) Any county or group of 2 or more counties may set an additional fee of up to [\$15] \$25 for each license.
- (2) The proceeds shall be used to fund domestic violence programs.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1986.
