- (1) THE PURCHASE, MAINTENANCE, AND REPAIR OF RESCUE APPARATUS AND EQUIPMENT; OR
- (2) THE MAINTENANCE AND REPAIR OF BUILDINGS NECESSARY FOR RESCUE SQUAD OPERATIONS.

32A-5.

A RESCUE SQUAD SHALL FILE ANNUALLY A REPORT ON THE RECEIPT AND DISBURSEMENT OF FUNDS RECEIVED UNDER THIS TITLE.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1986.

CHAPTER 229

(House Bill 833)

AN ACT concerning

Frederick County - Alcoholic Beverages - Inspector

FOR the purpose of altering the number of alcoholic beverages inspectors for Frederick County; repealing a provision on staggered terms of the Frederick County alcoholic beverages inspectors; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages inspectors for Frederick County.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages Section 149(d) Annotated Code of Maryland (1981 Replacement Volume and 1985 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

(d) (1) The Governor shall appoint [2] 1 alcoholic beverages [inspectors] INSPECTOR, with the advice and consent of:

(i) The Senate; or
