

(2) The date by which the renewal application must be received by the Board for the renewal to be issued and mailed before the license expires; and

(3) The amount of the renewal fee.

(c) Before a license expires, the licensee periodically may renew it for an additional term, if the licensee:

(1) Otherwise is entitled to be licensed;

(2) Pays to the Board:

(i) A renewal fee of \$20; or

(ii) A renewal fee of not more than \$2 that is set by the Board if the licensee certifies to the Board that the licensee provides professional services only as a volunteer [to a voluntary nonprofit organization]; and

(3) Submits to the Board a renewal application on the form that the Board requires.

(d) (1) The Board shall renew the license of each licensee who meets the requirements of this section.

(2) A volunteer's license issued under paragraph (c)(2)(ii) of this section shall be clearly designated as a volunteer's license.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1986.

CHAPTER 234

(House Bill 882)

AN ACT concerning

Child Abuse and Neglect - Records and Reports
