CHAPTER 236

(House Bill 909)

AN ACT concerning

Somerset County - Sanitary Commission

FOR the purpose of altering certain interest rates that the Sanitary Commission in Somerset County may charge when certain benefit assessments are in default; and generally relating to the operation of the Sanitary Commission in Somerset County.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article - Health - Environmental Section 9-659(d) Annotated Code of Maryland (1982 Volume and 1985 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Health - Environmental

9-659.

- (d) Payment of a benefit assessment made under this section:
 - (1) Is due when levied by the sanitary commission;
- (2) Is in default 60 days after the payment is due; and
- (3) When in default, bears interest [at the rate of 0.5 percent a month] from the date of default:
- (I) IN SOMERSET COUNTY, AT THE RATE SET BY THE SANITARY COMMISSION; AND
- (II) IN ALL OTHER COUNTIES, AT THE RATE OF 0.5 PERCENT A MONTH.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1986.
