country an examination that [is] WAS similar to the examination [for which the applicant is seeking the waiver] THAT THEN WAS GIVEN IN THIS STATE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1986.

## CHAPTER 241

(House Bill 1070)

AN ACT concerning

Board of Chiropractic Examiners

FOR the purpose of altering the membership of the Board of Chiropractic Examiners; altering the term of Board members; and generally relating to the Board of Chiropractic Examiners.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article - Health Occupations Section 3-202(a) and (f) Annotated Code of Maryland (1981 Volume and 1985 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Health Occupations

3-202.

and

- (a) (1) The Board consists of [four] 5 members.
  - (2) Of the [four] 5 members:
    - (i) [Three] 4 shall be licensed chiropractors;
      - (ii) [One] I shall be a consumer member.
- (3) The Governor shall appoint the chiropractor members, with the advice of the Secretary, AND WITH THE ADVICE AND CONSENT OF THE SENATE, from a list of qualified individuals submitted to the Governor by the Maryland Chiropractic
