CHAPTER 241

(House Bill 1070)

AN ACT concerning

Board of Chiropractic Examiners

FOR the purpose of altering the membership of the Board of Chiropractic Examiners; altering the term of Board members; and generally relating to the Board of Chiropractic Examiners.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article - Health Occupations
Section 3-202(a) and (f)
Annotated Code of Maryland
(1981 Volume and 1985 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Health Occupations

3-202.

(a) (1) The Board consists of [four] 5 members.

(2) Of the [four] 5 members:

(i) [Three] 4 shall be licensed chiropractors;
and

(ii) [One] 1 shall be a consumer member.

(3) The Governor shall appoint the chiropractor members, with the advice of the Secretary, AND WITH THE ADVICE AND CONSENT OF THE SENATE, from a list of qualified individuals submitted to the Governor by the Maryland Chiropractic
