- (A) EACH COUNTY AND BALTIMORE CITY SHALL PREPARE AN EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS PLAN FOR RESPONDING TO AN EMERGENCY THAT INVOLVES HAZARDOUS MATERIALS OR CONTROLLED HAZARDOUS SUBSTANCES AS DEFINED IN HEALTH ENVIRONMENTAL ARTICLE.
