(a) (4) "Manufacturer, factory branch, or distributor" means a person, partnership, association, corporation, or entity engaged in the business of manufacturing or assembling motor vehicles or of distributing motor vehicles to motor vehicle dealers as defined in [§ 15-201(b), (c), and (d)] § 15-201(B) AND (E) of the Transportation Article.

DRAFTER'S NOTE: This corrects erroneous cross-references in § 14-1501(a)(4) of the Commercial Law Article.
