

(2) Is feasible financially and from an engineering standpoint.

(E) IN WORCESTER COUNTY, IN CONSIDERING A PROPOSED SERVICE AREA, THE SANITARY COMMISSION AND THE GOVERNING BODY OF WORCESTER COUNTY MAY NOT CREATE OR CHANGE A SERVICE AREA UNLESS THEY FIND THAT THE CREATION OR CHANGE:

(1) IS NECESSARY FOR THE EXISTING OR FUTURE HEALTH, SAFETY, AND WELFARE OF THE PUBLIC IN GENERAL; AND

(2) IS FEASIBLE FINANCIALLY AND FROM AN ENGINEERING STANDPOINT.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act ~~shall take effect July 1, 1987.~~ is declared to be an emergency measure and necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety and having been passed by a ye and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, it shall take effect from the date of its passage.
