- (1) THE MASTER PLUMBER DOES NOT ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH A PURCHASER OF PRACTICAL PLUMBING SERVICES; AND
- (2) THE PERSON, FIRM, OR CORPORATION THAT EMPLOYS THE MASTER PLUMBER HAS MET THE INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION.
- (F) THE BOARD SHALL SPECIFY ON THE LICENSE WHETHER THE MASTER PLUMBER MEETS THE INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SECTION.
- (G) THE BOARD MAY SUSPEND OR REVOKE THE LICENSE OF ANY MASTER PLUMBER WHO, EITHER INDIVIDUALLY OR AS AN EMPLOYEE, ENTERS INTO A CONTRACT TO PROVIDE PRACTICAL PLUMBING SERVICES WITHOUT THE INSURANCE COVERAGE REQUIRED IN SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION.
- (H) ANY PERSON, FIRM, OR CORPORATION WHICH KNOWINGLY AND WILLFULLY PROVIDES PRACTICAL PLUMBING SERVICES WITHOUT THE INSURANCE COVERAGE REQUIRED IN SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION SHALL BE GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR AND, UPON CONVICTION THEREOF, SHALL BE SUBJECT TO A FINE NOT TO EXCEED \$1,000, OR IMPRISONMENT NOT TO EXCEED 6 MONTHS, OR BOTH.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is declared to be an emergency measure and necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety and having been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, it shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 236

(House Bill 686)

AN ACT concerning

Vehicle Laws - Travel Trailers and Motor Homes -Length Limitations

FOR the purpose, of altering the definition of the term "travel trailer" to include a fifth wheel travel trailer up to a certain length; altering the maximum permissible length of certain vehicles; defining a certain term; and generally relating to the maximum permissible length of certain vehicles.
