

(i) The full power of arrest, the service of process of all writs, summonses, orders, petitions, subpoenas, warrants, rules to show cause, and all other legal papers;

(ii) The care and supervision of prisoners at any of the county detention centers, hospitals, penal institutions, or other places of confinement;

(iii) The security of all State and county courts and perform such duties as may be required of them by the courts;

(iv) The transportation of all legally detained persons; and

(v) Neither the Sheriff of Prince George's County nor any of his deputies shall conduct criminal investigations, except in matters concerning the Sheriff's department or upon request of the courts.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1987.

AN ACT concerning

Prince George's County - Office of the State's Attorney

FOR the purpose of altering the salaries of the deputy State's Attorney, the assistant State's Attorneys, and the administrative assistant in Prince George's County; increasing the number of assistant State's Attorneys; and generally relating to the office of the State's Attorney in Prince George's County.
