

shall pay contributions at the standard rate of 2.7 percent of wages paid by the employer during the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1964, and during each fiscal year thereafter with respect to employment occurring after June 30, 1964, through June 30, 1984, except as otherwise provided in this article. For the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1984, and during each fiscal year thereafter, each employer shall pay contributions at the standard rate of 5.4 percent of wages paid by the employer with respect to employment occurring after June 30, 1984, except as otherwise provided in this article.

(10) For the purposes of the experience-rating provisions of this subsection, in any case where a claim for benefits is filed, an employer's account shall not be charged with benefits paid, for the purposes of any computation made for any fiscal year beginning after the date of separation from employment, if the claimant: (i) leaves the service of the employer voluntarily without good cause attributable to his employer; (ii) is separated from the service of the employer and admits or is found guilty of having committed any criminal act against the employer; or (iii) leaves the service of the employer voluntarily with good cause if the voluntary leaving was to accept better employment OR TO ENTER APPROVED TRAINING as determined by the Secretary.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1987.

CHAPTER 262

(House Bill 1199)

AN ACT concerning

Fisheries - Finfish Sizes

FOR the purpose of altering the minimum size limit for sea trout and weakfish; establishing a certain minimum size limit for red drum or channel bass; establishing a certain possession limit for red drum or channel bass over a certain size; and generally relating to the legal size of certain finfish.
